If you are a SF resident, and receive Medi-Cal, you may be eligible for In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) to help you remain safely in your home as an alternative to out-of-home placement













Are you a Medi-Cal Recipient?

Call/Visit San Francisco's Department of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) to apply: 2 Gough Street 415-355-6700 Get assessed by an IHSS Social Worker

IHSS will send a Social Worker to complete a home visit and assess your in-home needs. Notification of Services

If approved, you will receive a notice in the mail with the number of authorized hours. You can then hire an IHSS Provider.
